Date and Location

- The competition may take place on 24th July, 25th July and 26th July 2026 - **but these dates are not confirmed as of November 2024.**
- Venue to be confirmed - **but it will be in the UK.**
- The registration will take place from 4:00pm onwards on the 24th of July 2026.
- The competition will commence at 5pm promptly on 24th of July 2026.

Registration/Requirements

- Registration deadline is 1st January 2026.
- To participate in the competition, it is necessary to fill in the registration form, attaching the copy of the passport or other valid form of identification.
- All competitors must be accompanied at all times by their ID during the competition.
- In order to participate, competitors must be registered in a timely manner, within the time frame set for registration.
- If the participant is a minor, his registration must be done by the parent or guardian who must attach his ID along with the ID of the minor competitor. All responsibility for the follow-up of the minor during the competition will be of their parent or guardian.
- If any registered competitor cannot be present on one of the days of the contest, they must notify the organisation by email at info@habibulquraan.co.uk at least 72 hours in advance.
- Applicants who fulfil the competition entry requirements will be invited for an interview, details of which will be sent to the applicants by email.
- Applicants will be informed of the interview result by email.
- Successful applicants will be invited to participate in the competition.
- The applicants must adhere to the age limit in the selected category, your date of birth will be checked and if it exceeds the limit, your application will be cancelled.
- All applicants will bare the cost of flights & visas, the organisation is not responsible of these costs.

- If any contestant misses their flight, the organisation will not bare any responsibility.
- Accommodation, food and transportation will be provided by the organisation.
- In terms of accommodation, hotel is not necessary, any type of accommodation will be provided.
- The organisation reserves the right to change your reading time.
- The organisation will select 20 contestants in category A, 25 contestants in category B, 25 contestants in category C, 15 contestants in category D, 15 contestants in category E and 15.
- Category C & B contestants must be accompanied by the guardian at all times
- The contestant is not allowed to apply for the same category if they have already achieved a position.
- All contestants must be present on the last day of the prize giving ceremony.
- The organisation will take responsibility of food and accommodation one day before the competition and one day after.

Competition Rules

The competition is divided into 5 categories:

- **Category A - 30 Juz: Maximum age 25 years.**
- **Category B - 20 Juz: Juz 1 to 20 Maximum age: 20 years.**
- **Category C - 10 Juz: Juz 1 to 10 Maximum age: 15 years.**
- **Category D - Full Quraan in Qira'ah (Dialect) • Max Age: 30**
- **Category E - Tafseer, Full Quraan – Commentary of the Quraan in Arabic & English, Maximum Age 30**

- The organisation reserves the right to change/modify the rules of the contest at any time.
- The judges decision is final. Any complaints from participants should be sent in writing to the organisation to the following email:

- If applications to any category fall short of the minimum target set by the Habibul Quraan, the organisation reserves the right to cancel the competition in that category. However, awards of appreciation will still be given to all the applicants in that category.

- Any candidate who does not comply with these terms and conditions will have his application cancelled.

Evaluation Criteria

- The best contestants from each category will be selected, being the number of contestants defined by the Organisation and announced on the day of the final.

- Each competitor will be responsible for their flight, visa, and other related expenses.
- The organisation is not responsible for the loss of any personal belongings/objects of the participants, accompanying persons or the public.
